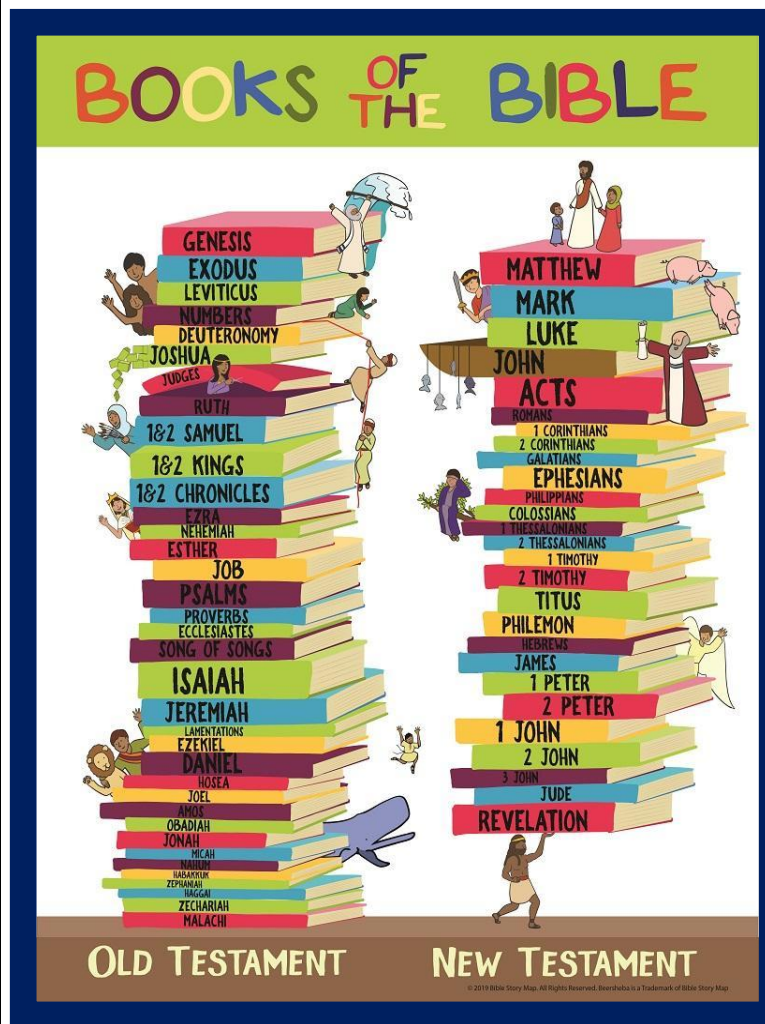
Why is it good to remember the stories Jesus told?

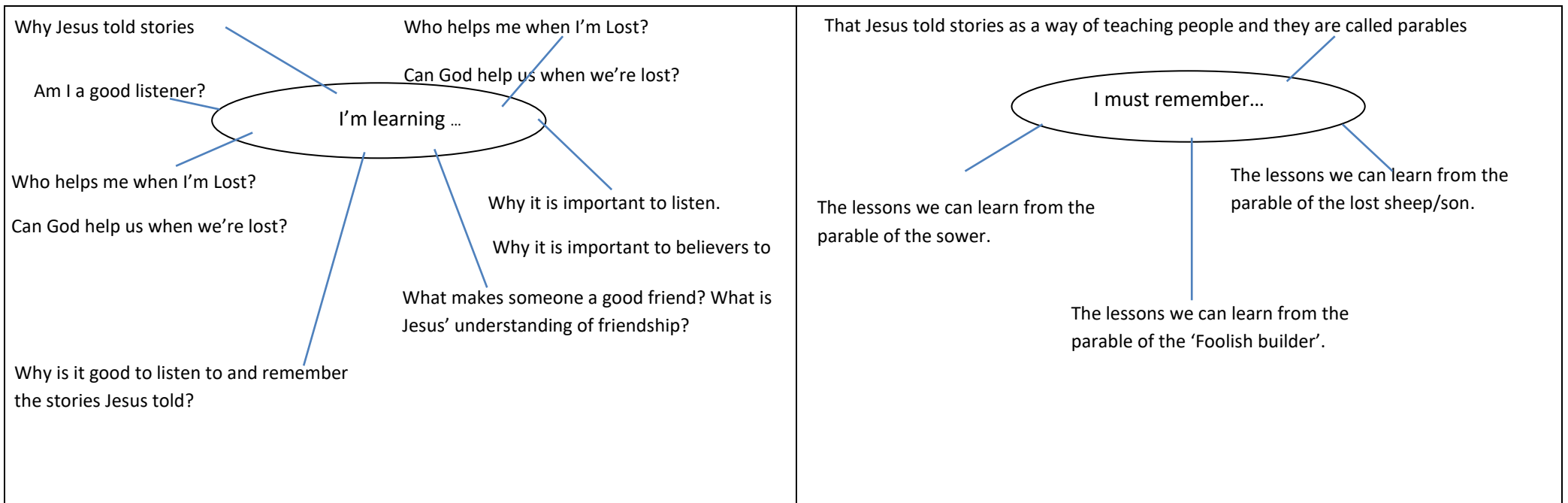
