

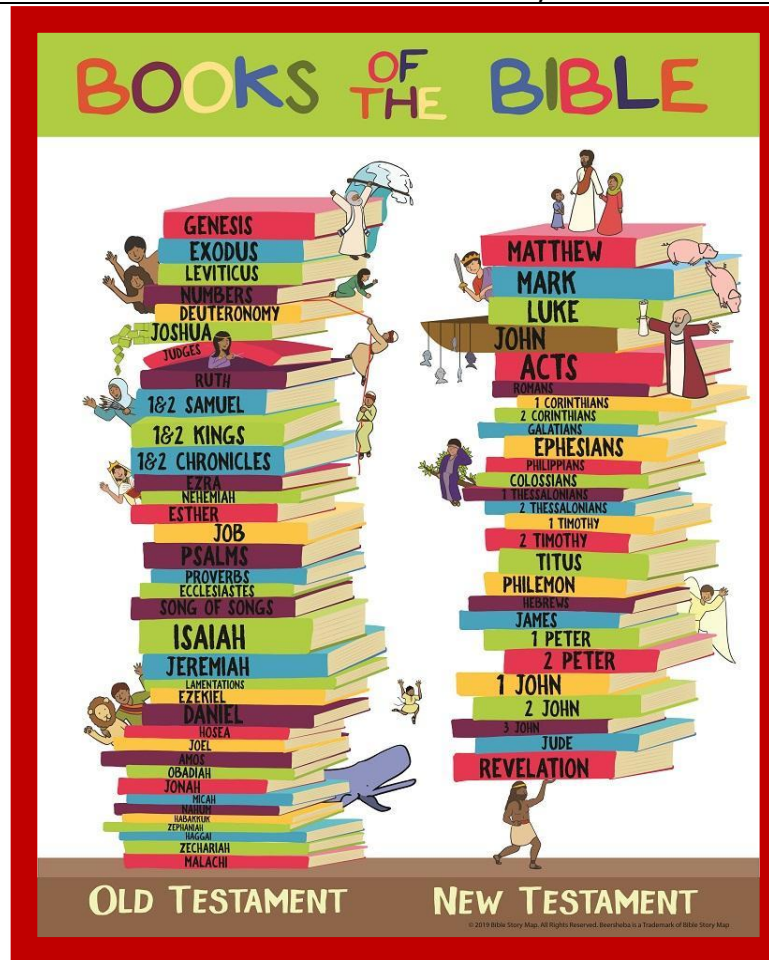

In the first few weeks of school you will be looking at Remembrance. Why is it important to remember and How does remembering help the cause of peace?

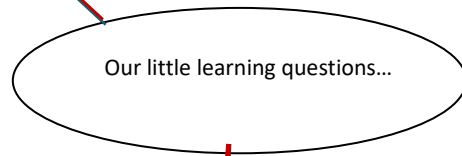

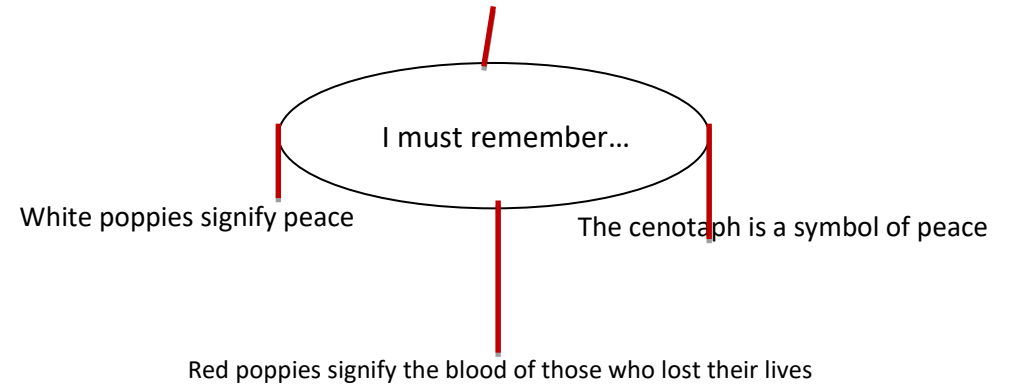

The cenotaph is a symbol of peace

Red poppies signify the blood of those who lost their lives

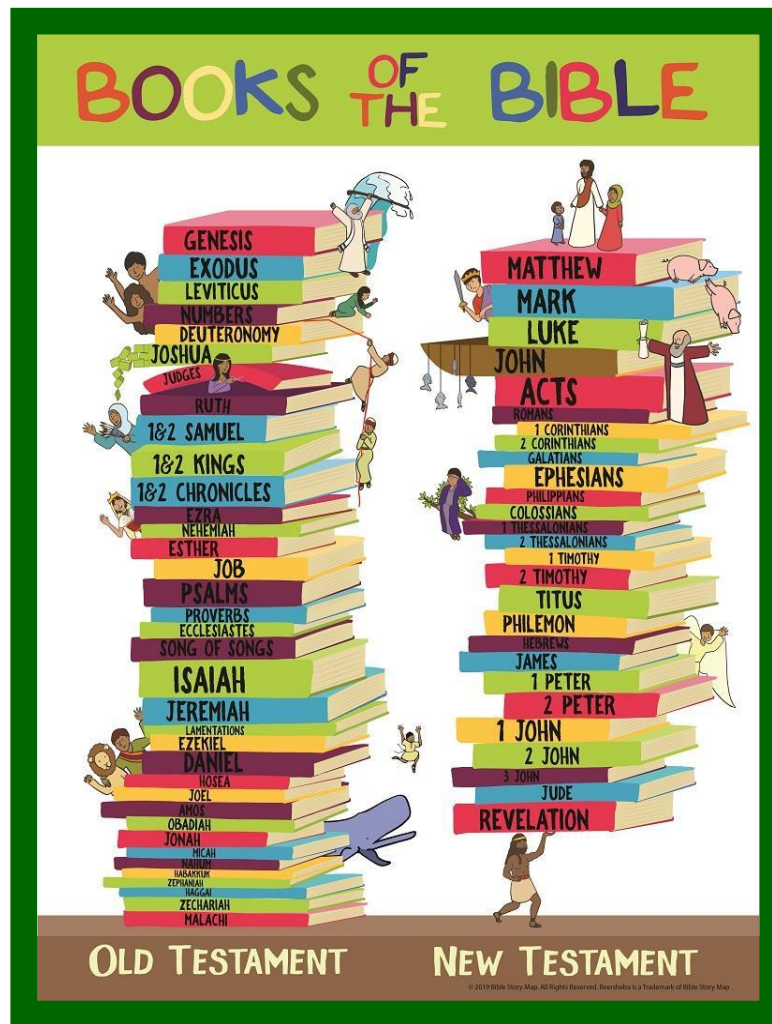
