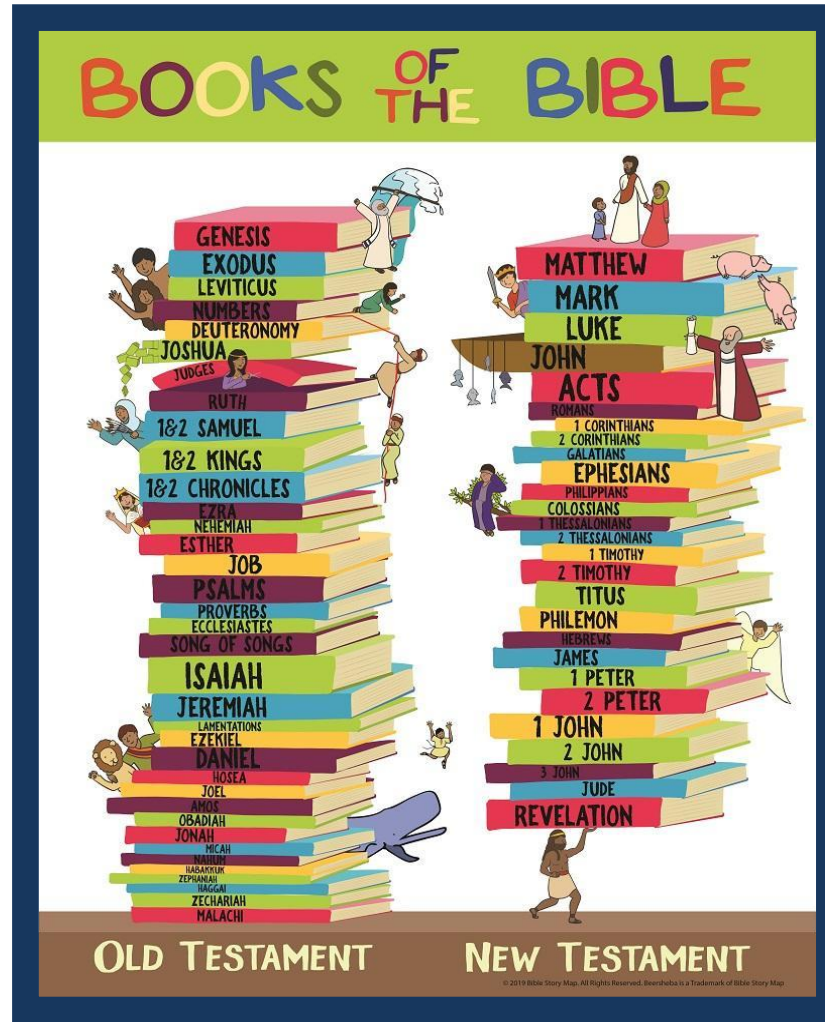
What are God's rules for living?

these rules

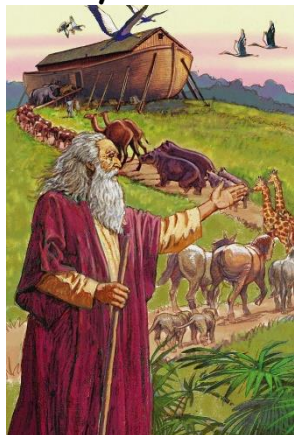
Rules are given to help us live well.

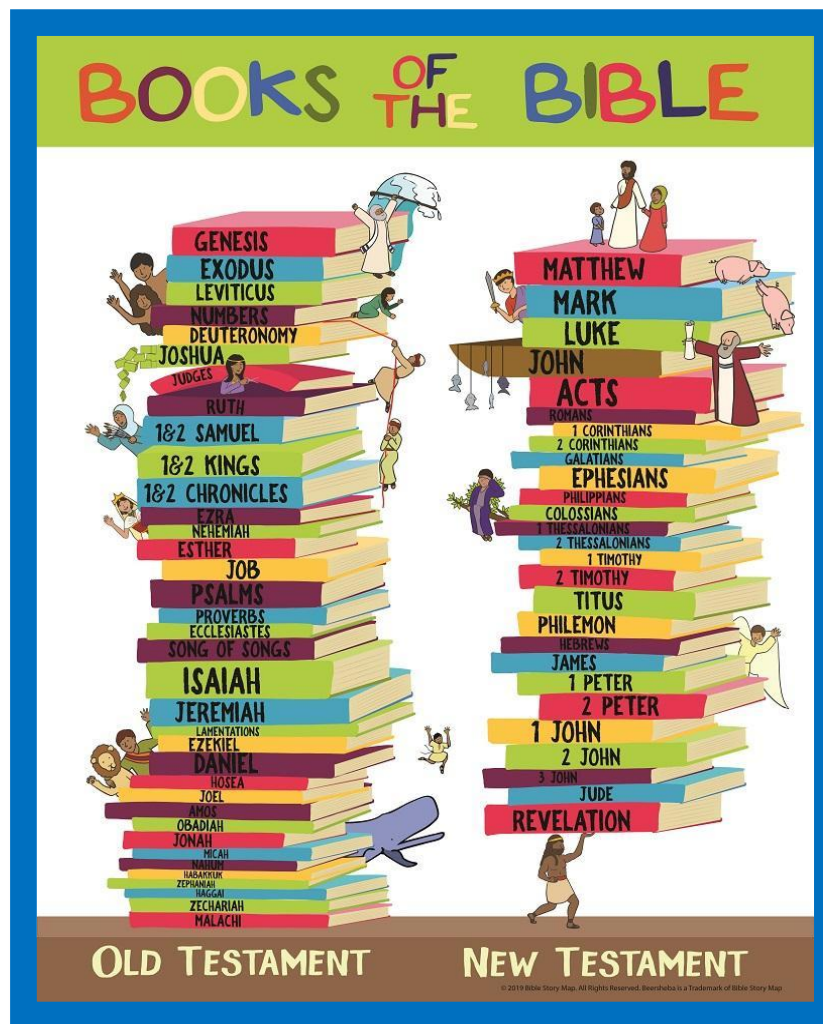
What is the story of Noah really about?
